Pastor Winston Persaud will ioin us for worship on Sunday, February 19th as well as during the education hour following worship.

As part of the observance of the teers, we are not offering 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation, Prof. Persaud will also give a presentation in our Fellowship Hall at 2pm on the historic Joint Declaration on the Doctrine of Justification (JDDJ), signed by Lutheran World Federation and The Roman Catholic Church, 31 October 1999. We will look at how the JDDJ points us forward in living in the truth of Jesus' prayer, "Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so 2 that they may be one, as we are one" (John 17:11b). This presentation is open to the public.


deemer Lutheran Church, prior to joining the faculty of Wartburg Theological Seminary, in February
