The word 'call' can mean so many things!

A call can be what we receive on our phones when someone wants to talk with us. As a pastor I'm familiar with what it means to be **called**, sometimes at all hours and in all circumstances.

Or we can be called certain names and titles. I'm called Janet. I'm called Pastor. I'm called friend or colleague. I'm called Mom or wife or sister.

At our baptism each of us is **called** by the Holy Spirit to trust in the grace and love of God, who **calls** us by name and gives us the identity of beloved son or daughter, marked with the cross of Christ forever. Then those who are gathered around the newly baptized call them into a shared mission of bearing God's creative and redeeming word to all the world now **called** a member of the body of Christ.

Then there is the 'Call of the Church.' In June of 2015 I received a Letter of Call from St. John's into a ministry of Word and Sacrament to serve as your pastor. We have faithfully journeyed together in this sacred calling.

The MLH is one of our legacies as a congregation. Through the caring ministry which happens there, we have made a difference in the lives of many people for over 65 years. My prayer is that this ministry will continue way into the future - with the full support of St. John's.

On the Sunday I came – I told you my favorite Bible verse – Romans 8:39. Of course, there are many Bible verses which I hold in my heart and in my head – but this verse constantly remains with me – because it sums up for me the essence of the Christian faith.
