Church Council Highlights

The following are some highlights from the December 21, 2023 meeting of our church council.

- Rev. Karen Tews attended the meeting as our Interim Pastor. She reported that she has been with us for a month already, leading worship services, teaching Confirmation Classes, and making visits to our members. She has enjoyed meeting so many people, attending the Sarah Circle and All Teams meetings, as well as our Courtyard Christmas Tree Lighting & Caroling and the Spaghetti Supper.
- Council approved the 2024 Budget as outlined in the Treasurer's Report.
- The Service Team reported that approximately 70 people attended the Meet & Greet for our Pastoral Candidate, Rev. Elise Rothfusz, following worship on December 10th. The Team is planning a welcome reception/luncheon after the Annual Meeting on January 28th. Meat, drinks, and cake will be provided. Everyone is asked to bring a dish to pass. (Information will be shared with the Congregation.)
- Council is looking into purchasing two 86" TV monitors and mounts for the Sanctuary.
- The Outreach Team shared that the Quilt Silent Auction was a big success again this year. Thank you to our quilting group for making this available to our congregation and community. Proceeds will be donated to the Youth fund.
- Youth Huddle met on December 13th to review the Spaghetti Supper and make notes of any changes to be considered for the coming year.
- The Property Team reported that the work is done on the parsonage and it looks good! The bushes around the parsonage will be cut back in the Spring.
- There will be <u>NO</u> All Teams Meeting in January; and the next Council meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 18th at 6:30pm.
- The Annual Meeting of St. John's Congregation is set for Sunday, January 28, 2024 (in the Fellowship Hall following worship). All teams should have their annual reports turned in to the office by Thursday, January 4, 2024.
