

### **An Update from our Seminarian, Maria Bonine**

Maria's Internship at St. John's-Evansville comes to an end on August 11th and classes resume at Wartburg Seminary on Tuesday, September 3rd. Sometime in the fall she will have her Candidacy Approval interview.

Maria will be taking classes this fall semester in Lutheran Ethics, Grief & Loss, Leadership in Multi-Point Parishes, Advanced Preaching, Capstone Seminar, Acts of the Apostles, Spiritual Practices, and Contemporary Crisis of Defining & Confessing the Gospel.


