June 28th: The Fourth Sunday after Pentecost

Genesis 22:1-14 In a severe test of faith, Abraham undertakes the sacrifice of his son.

Psalm 13 "How long, O Lord! Will you forget me forever?"

Romans 6:12-23 A virtuous life, free from the power of sin, is the goal of faithfulness to God.

Matthew 10:40-42 Hospitality to a disciple is the same as welcoming Christ himself.
