



# St. John's Finance News

Did you know that St. John's offers various ways for you to give financial support for all of our ministries: offerings collected at each worship service, offerings sent in the mail or dropped off at the office, automatic giving set up through the church office, and coming soon - PayPal on the new church website.

This year \$120,000 of the gifts, offerings, and Ministry Enhancement funds will be used for Benevolence Distribution to the following agencies. \$51,300 Mission Support to the NI Synod and the ELCA for Global Mission Relief and Developments. Programs such as the Malaria Project, World Hunger (Health Clinics, Water Wells, Food Supplies), HIV & AIDS Projects, Disaster Response Programs and Immigration and Refugee Services are a few of the ways the funds are used. \$17,583 to other various ministries such as Another Child Romanian Orphanage, Mendota Area Christian Food



The second activity of our **Feed The Need** project, will kick off on Sunday, April 30th and continue through Sunday, May 28th.

Our mission will be to stock St. John's Barnyard with honey bees, chicks, pigs, goats, and cows.

These animals will then be donated to God's Global Barnyard, part of the ELCA Good Gifts program. Farm animals are gifted to families around the world to help them escape the cycle of hunger and poverty for good. Animals provide food to eat, fertilizer to grow crops and offspring to sell on the market. Give a man a meal, and you feed him for a day. Help a man be a farmer, and he will feed himself and others for a lifetime!
