Festival of Music for the Season at St. John's Lutheran Church Sunday, November 27th at 2pm


We are excited to announce that we will be joined by Dr. Roy W. Carroll, cantor and organist at Wartburg Theological Seminary in Dubuque, Iowa.




shelter, and even slept a little bit! The picture at riaht was taken i around midnight while we were all still very awake!
