

Church Council Highlights

The following are some highlights from the September 21, 2023 meeting of our church council.

- Task Force reported that they are working with members of the Youth Huddle and the Outreach Team to organize the Fall Festival scheduled for Sunday, October 15th.
- There are no updates from the Synod regarding a possible Interim Pastor. The office will continue to schedule Pulpit Supply. James Younger is coordinating the worship services with our musicians and the visiting pastors. We are pleased that attendance numbers for in-person and online worship has been above our expectations.
- Educational Ministry Team shared that they met with available Sunday School teachers on September 7th to discuss the 2023-2024 school year. It was decided that the Sunday School offering will be handled in each classroom (instead of at the sign-in table). On Rally Day the students voted that St. Jude Children's Research Hospital will be the recipient of their SS offerings this year.
- Stewardship Team shared that the 2023 Stewardship Campaign will begin on October 29th with the distribution of Time, Talent & Giving sheets and end with "Harvest Celebration Sunday" on November 19th. There will be lay speakers for the four Sundays of the campaign.
- Memorial Team approved using Undesignated Memorial Funds to cover the following expenses: dead tree removal, lighting updates, and flooring at the parsonage; resealing and striping of the church parking lot.
- The Outreach/Evangelism Team shared that Quilt Sunday will be celebrated on September 24th with the display of 70+ quilts in the Sanctuary. The quilts will be packaged and delivered to Rockford in early October. The Team will also organize the dessert competition for the Fall Festival.
- Call Committee shared that an interview of their first candidate is being planned.
- The next All Teams Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 5th at 7pm; and the next Council meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 19th at 6:30pm.
